WHAT DAYS AND TIMES ARE THE VISITS AVAILABLE?

Dates and times for a visit to Father Time Wall can be found by searching 'FTW visit' via MCC's website at tours.lords.org. Further dates may be added subject to demand.

HOW MUCH WILL A VISIT COST?

A visit is free of charge and all visits must be pre-booked in advance via MCC's website at tours.lords.org. For the avoidance of doubt, no walk-up bookings will be taken by MCC.

HOW LONG WILL THE VISIT LAST?

Approximately 55 minutes.

WHAT WILL I SEE ON THE VISIT?

A steward of MCC will meet all pre-booked visitors promptly at the designated start time.

Visitors will be escorted to the Lord's Father Time Wall and will be met by a Lord's Tour Guide who will give an overview of the Wall, including the 100 greatest Milestones, before allowing all visitors time to enjoy and interact with the Wall and to take photos of plaques.

For the avoidance of doubt, no other areas within Lord's will be visited during the visit. This includes but is not limited to the Media Centre, Pavilion and MCC Museum. To see those areas, visitors will need to pre-book a Lord's Tour via MCC's website tours.lords.org.

CAN I CHANGE OR CANCEL MY VISIT?

Yes. If you wish to cancel your visit and any added extras such as a cream tea in the Lord's Tavern, please email tours@mcc.org.uk. You will need to do this at least 72 hours prior to the commencement of your visit to receive a refund for any extras purchased.

WHERE DO WE MEET?

Entry to Lord's to shall only be via the North Gate entrance on Wellington Place unless otherwise stated on MCC's website.

WHAT TIME SHOULD I ARRIVE FOR MY VISIT?

MCC recommends that you arrive 10 minutes prior to the start time of your visit to allow sufficient time to clear security. Please note that you will not be permitted to enter Lord's until 10 minutes prior to the commencement of your visit.

IS THERE ANYWHERE TO LEAVE LUGGAGE OR BAGS?

Only small handbags and rucksacks will be allowed to be taken on a visit. This is to assist with MCC's security checks and minimise unnecessary contact. For the avoidance of any doubt, there are no locker or luggage storage facilities available at Lord's.

ARE THERE TOILETS?

Yes, toilets will be open for visitors, with regular cleaning in place.

IS THERE ANYWHERE I CAN EAT AT THE GROUND?

Catering facilities are closed inside the Ground however The Lord's Tavern pub is open. Pre-booking is recommended via lords.org/tavern or alternatively, you can select an extra when booking via lords.org/tours

CAN I PARK AT LORD'S?

There are no parking facilities available at Lord's.

The nearest car park to Lord's is Q-park St John's Wood located outside the congestion zone.

On street parking is available outside the ground, for more information and prices please check the Westminster council website.
