### **London Spirit Men's Team Assistant Coach (Fielding)**

**Team:** London Spirit Men's Team  
**Reporting to:** Head Coach, London Spirit Men  
**Contract:** One Year Fixed Term

### **DIMENSIONS OF ROLE**

- The Hundred competition will take place in August 2025 and, during that month, the Assistant Coach will be required to remain with the London Spirit squad, staying in the team hotel and being available on each day.
- London Spirit's home ground is Lord's Cricket Ground in London, where the teams will play four matches. There will also be 4 away matches, at The Oval, Cardiff, Birmingham and Manchester, plus the possibility of a semi-final and a final.
- Additionally, input may be required for the player-retention and draft process from the date of appointment onwards.

### **KEY PURPOSE OF ROLE**

To assist the Head Coach in preparing the playing squad on both practice and match days, focussing on fielding but with scope to branch out to other areas. This will involve active participation in all training sessions, as well as working with the players and other back-room staff on specific tactics.

### **KEY TASKS AND ACCOUNTABILITIES**

- To work with the players in training sessions and pre-match preparations, using specific skill-specialism in fielding as relevant.
- A key factor will be to bring energy and dynamism to the group and to have an upbeat presence around the dressing room.

- To ensure that all necessary training aids, balls and equipment are suitably set up in time for all training sessions.
- To work with the captain and the Head Coach on tactical issues, including analysis of the opposition.
- To advise on the retention and drafting of players to enable the team to perform well in the 2025 season.
- To carry out media/press obligations as required.
- To undertake any other reasonable duties as requested.

- Minimum ECB Level 3 Coaching qualification or equivalent.
- Experience as at least an Assistant Coach of a team in a similar domestic, franchise or international environment, or as a recently retired former professional player starting their coaching journey.
- Strong knowledge of players in men's domestic and international cricket.
- Current DBS / Working with Children certificate.
- First Aid and Safeguarding Young People qualifications.

## **REMUNERATION**

- Salary commensurate with candidate experience.
- All travel within the UK and accommodation costs will be covered during the period of the tournament, in addition to receiving daily expenses. International travel expenses will not be reimbursed.
