

TERMS & CONDITIONS

COMMUNITY CRICKET HEROES 2025

Marylebone Cricket Club of Lord's, London NW8 8QN (**MCC**) is the organiser of the prize which is given to 11 individuals who have made an outstanding contribution to grassroots cricket and their community, who shall be honoured as a "Community Cricket Hero" and invited to attend a day of hospitality at Lord's for one of the following fixtures to be played in 2025: (i) England v India women's ODI on 19 July; (ii) the London Spirit v Northern Superchargers (double-header) group match forming part of The Hundred on Wednesday 20 August; (iii) the London Spirit v Southern Brave (double-header) group match forming part of The Hundred on 23 August; (iv) or England v South Africa men's ODI on Thursday 4 September (the **Prize**).

- 1. Any person (**Nominator**) is eligible to nominate a person over the age of 18 (**Nominee**) for the Prize. The Nominee must have made an outstanding contribution to grassroots cricket and their community.
- 2. By entering the competition, the Nominator will be deemed to have accepted these terms & conditions. MCC reserves the right to refuse a nomination to anyone in breach of these terms & conditions.
- 3. In order to make a nomination, the Nominator must visit <u>here</u> (**Website**) and tell MCC why the Nominee should be given the Prize taking into account the 'guidance for entry'.
- 4. Nominations will be accepted from midnight (GMT) on 25 April 2025 and must be received no later than 23.59 (BST) on 4 June 2025.
- 5. MCC may contact the Nominator to verify certain facts and/or events. This should not be interpreted as anything other than an information gathering exercise. Further ongoing research may also be undertaken by MCC if required.
- 6. MCC will appoint a judging panel who will meet to select the 11 Prize winners based on their entries. The decision of the judging panel is final, and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
- 7. The Prize winner(s) will be notified by email (using the contact details provided by the Nominator) on or around 23 June 2025 and invited to attend either the women's or men's ODI, or one of The Hundred double-header group matches (Match Day), as decided by MCC in its absolute discretion. Each Prize winner has 5 days after being notified by MCC to confirm whether they can attend the Match Day. If a Prize winner cannot attend the Match Day, MCC will use reasonable endeavours to offer an alternative day subject always to availability. If the Prize winner fails to confirm their attendance or MCC cannot offer an alternative day, and the Prize winner will forfeit the opportunity to attend without liability.
- 8. Following acceptance to attend the Match Day pursuant to Clause 7, MCC will notify the Prize winners of the arrangements for the day in advance of the Match Day.
- 9. The Prize winners are responsible for their own costs in attending the Match Day.
- 10. The use of the Prize to enter Lord's constitutes acceptance of the above.
- 11. The Prize winners acknowledge and agree that play is not guaranteed on the Match Day and in the event of no play on the day due to adverse weather or the match concluding before its scheduled conclusion, no alternative day or match will be offered.
- 12. The Prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered.



- 13. MCC is not responsible for any late, incomplete, incorrectly submitted nominations or any technical glitches or malfunctions on the Website or any other problems out of its control that result in a nomination not being properly received by MCC.
- 14. MCC cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by Nominator or Nominee as a result of using the Website or as a result of not winning the Prize.
- 15. By making a nomination, the Nominator grants to MCC a perpetual non-exclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free, worldwide, fully sub-licensable right to publish, broadcast and post the nomination online and on any other platform MCC chooses from time to time. This licence will be deemed to include all the necessary rights and permissions to enable such use by MCC.
- 16. MCC reserves the right to disqualify any nomination which breaches any of these terms & conditions, brings MCC, Lord's or the good name of cricket in general into disrepute or void, cancel, suspend, or amend the process where it becomes necessary to do so.
- 17. MCC will not be liable for any loss, expense or damage which is suffered or sustained in connection with the competition or accepting or using the Prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
- 18. MCC reserves the right to vary these terms & conditions at any time including but not limited to the opening and closing times for nominations or cancellation of the Prize, at any stage, if in its opinion it is deemed necessary or if circumstances arise outside its control.
- 19. Any personal information collected by MCC shall be used by MCC for the purposes of administering the Prize and will not be provided to a third party without an individual's consent. All personal data shall be processed in accordance MCC's Privacy Notice which may be viewed at lords.org/privacynotice.
- 20. The Prize process will be governed by English law.
