Notice to MCC Members

Members should read these Terms & Conditions for entry into the ballot for a ticket to attend the New Zealand Test Match in conjunction with the Club's email to them dated 31 March 2021 and available to review at lords.org/nztestmatch

- 1 This ballot is run by Marylebone Cricket Club (**MCC**).
- 2 All Full, Senior and Associate MCC Members (**Members**) are eligible to enter the ballot for a ticket (at no charge) to attend the New Zealand Test Match (save that Senior and Associate Members are eligible to enter the ballot for Days 4 and 5 only).
- 3 There is no fee or purchase necessary to enter the ballot.
- 4 By entering this ballot, Members will be deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these Terms & Conditions and the 2021 Terms & Conditions for the Sale and Allocation of Tickets for the England v New Zealand Test Match (**NZ Ts&Cs**) which are hereby incorporated into these Terms & Conditions save that in the event of any discrepancy between these Terms & Conditions and the NZ Ts&Cs, these Terms & Conditions shall prevail.
- 5 The ballot opens at 08:00 on Tuesday 6 April 2021 and closes at 16:00 on Tuesday 13 April 2021. Entries must be made via a Member's account on MCC's Ticket Platform, SRO at: tickets.lords.org
- 6 Members are limited to one entry for each day of the New Zealand Test Match. No bulk entries will be accepted and duplicate entries will be disqualified.
- 7 The successful Members will be drawn from the ballot entries and will be notified via email to the email address registered as part of their SRO account by Friday 23 April.
- 8 MCC cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by a Member as a result of entering the ballot or as a result of not obtaining a ticket to attend the New Zealand Test Match.
- 9 MCC is not responsible for any technical glitches or malfunctions or any other problems out of its control that result in an entry not being properly received by MCC
- 10 By entering this ballot, a Member has accepted and acknowledged that the New Zealand Test Match will be held in accordance with relevant government guidelines in force at the time of the match and any conditions and/or operational requirements in the safety certificate required and issued for the holding of the New Zealand Test Match.
