



Lord's Cricket World Cup 2019 Accreditation Guidelines

Please read the following guidelines for further information with regards to applying for Lord's Cricket World Cup 2019 Accreditation:

- Accreditation will manage access to Lord's on match days only (including warm-ups) during the tournament. People working exclusively on non-match days (e.g. build-up phase) are not required to apply for a CWC19 Accreditation.
- The process allows CWC19 to identify individuals with a working function during the tournament. It will also assist with controlling access into accredited spaces and help to ensure the safety and security of all CWC19 participants.
- Accreditation is a personal and non-transferable device.
- **Accreditation applications must be submitted by 17 May 2019 or you will not be accredited for CWC19.**

Accreditation Collection

- All applicants are asked to collect their accreditation at the Venue Accreditation Centre prior to the first CWC19 match at Lord's which takes place on Sunday, 23rd June.
- The Venue Accreditation Centre for Lord's is located in the Thomas Lord Suite / Entrance by St John's Wood Road.
- To collect your accreditation, you must bring either a valid UK Driving License, Passport or a UK Biometric Residence Permit.
- Unless you hear otherwise, from either Marylebone Cricket Club or the ICC Cricket World Cup, your application has been successful and will be ready for collection at the Lord's Venue Accreditation Centre.
