

We deliver projects across the UK and around the world, providing free coaching and match play to young people from under-served communities, empowering boys and girls to reach their full potential in the game.

BY HARNESSING THE TRANSFORMATIVE POWER OF CRICKET, OUR PROJECTS:



ACROSS THE UK

We run a nationwide network of Hubs empowering promising youngsters from under-served communities to develop their hard-ball skills, join cricket clubs and access the talent pathway.

The Hubs help those who have been engaged through non-traditional formats or mass participation initiatives to transition into the formal cricketing structures and build a life-long love of the game.



WHAT IS A MCCF HUB?

- An MCCF Hub is a free-to-access cricket training centre
- Locations across England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland
- Available to state school players aged 11-16
- Offering opportunity to thousands of talented girls and boys each year
- 10 weeks of high-quality hardball winter coaching

- Experienced male and female coaches and mentors
- Access to holistic support (known as our "Cricket+" programme)
 - Supplementing development beyond cricket
 - Supporting mental and physical wellbeing

SUMMER MATCH PLAY

- National Hub Competition
 - A knock-out U16 tournament open to all Hubs
 - Boys' and Girls' Finals held on the Main Ground at Lord's
- U14 festival days around the country including a competition in the Indoor Cricket Centre and Nursery Ground at Lord's
- Regional Springboard Programmes offering our most talented players the chance to train with elite coaches and compete in regional tournaments

Overseas, we work with partners to provide life-changing opportunities by harnessing the transformative power of cricket and the MCC brand to open up access to the game.

1 LEBANON

In Lebanon, MCCF supports the Alsama Project funding several of its Cricket Hubs for Syrian refugees from encampments in and around Beirut. The children receive year-round coaching and match play which provides them with much needed joy and welcome relief from the hardships they face.



NEPAL

There is huge passion for cricket across Nepal, but a lack of investment and infrastructure. We are nurturing the next generation of cricketers by taking cricket into schools and communities. With a focus on empowering women and girls, we are using the game as a tool to tackle harmful gender norms.



SRI LANKA

Talent is universal but opportunity is not. Access to high-quality cricket in Sri Lanka is often the preserve of those in the major cities. We work with partners to provide cricket scholarships to girls from rural communities, supporting their development. Many have gone on to play for the Sri Lanka National Team.



EAST AFRICA

Our projects in Rwanda, Uganda, and Kenya are making an incredible impact with thousands of young people engaged on our programmes. We are helping these countries to bridge the gap between softball cricket and the talent pathway, supporting the National Cricket Associations in the region and transforming lives through cricket.



SOUTH AFRICA

MCCF supports a Women's Empowerment Programme for girls from townships around Cape Town. Bringing together hundreds of female players from these communities, the programme is providing individuals with access to high-quality cricket coaching and a life-skills programme.
